Overview of the Position

Reporting to the President, the Controller will be responsible for oversight of all finance, accounting and reporting activities. The Controller will be the financial leader and business partner for the COO and be involved in supporting presentations to the board and senior leadership team. The Controller will work closely with functional leaders and their staffs, not only to educate them regarding finance and accounting procedures but also to explore how the finance function can support department goals and objectives. This position will be responsible for the development and maintenance of the financial reporting systems of the company in accordance with the company objectives and generally accepted accounting principles.
